Introduction: Love is what makes family a family.

Text: Ephesians 3:14-15

Basic Questions:

- 1. How does a person become a member of the human family?
- 2. How does a person become a member of God's spiritual family?
- 3. How does a person get born-again spiritually?
- 4. Why is spiritual rebirth required of all people to become God's spiritual children?
- 5. Which is God's family in heaven (Eph. 3:15)?
- 6. God's family on earth-the church militant-is engaged in warfare. Why?
- 7. What are the connotations of "circle" as it relates to the family of God?
- 8. In our family circle, who do we have?
- **A.** We have God as our Father, who is committed to our spiritual training and development (Heb. 12:5-8, 10-11).
- **B.** We have Jesus as our Big Brother, who defeated temptation, the devil, and death for us (Heb. 2:11-18).
- **C.** We have the Holy Spirit as our Counselor who comforts us, teaches us, and guides us (John 14:15-17; 15:26).

Application/Conclusion:

- As God's family circle, God must always be in the <u>center</u> of our life—why?
- To win people to Christ as a winning church, our identity as a "family of God" must be <u>real</u>, because people are usually attracted to follow Christ when they see <u>love</u> in action among members of the church (John 13:34-35; Col. 3:12-14).

3. Challenge: Let us ask God daily to help us _____ up to our noble identity as the family of God.
