b. For <u>use</u> in time of sudden need	
2. Apply:	
 a. Our capability to <u>cope</u> with life emergencies is a mark of a winning life, like Job in the OT. 	
b. Our capability to <u>withstand</u> the storms or difficulties of life that beat against us, is a mark of a winning life, illustrated by Jesus in His parable of the Wise and Foolish Builders.	
c. Unexpected emergencies can come to us totest our winning life.
