Text: Luke 12:13-21

2nd Sermon: Basic Wisdom Learned From the Mistakes of the Rich Fool

1. If we fail to plan, we plan to fail.
2. The Rich Fool failed because he suddenly died without a plan for his next life, and he lost everything, including his soul.
3. Here are nuggets of wisdom from the mistakes of the Rich Fool.

A. Don’t get wrapped up with yourself when you experience material prosperity.

B. Understand that there is more to life than material riches.

C. Understand that there is more to life than physical pleasure.

D. Be aware that God is watching you and God can suddenly terminate your life anytime.

E. Don’t make a fool of yourself by excluding God from the plan of your life.

Reflection:

1. Life on earth is relatively short—70 to 80 plus years compared to eternity.
2. This is why we need Godly wisdom to plan our life to make God the first and the highest priority of all that we are, all that we have, all that we do, and all that we hope to be—for the glory of God!

Read: Revelation 5:9
