- 4. Critique / Compare & Contrast the "American Dream"
 [Anyone, regardless of where they were born or what class they were born into, can attain their own version of success in a society where upward mobility is possible for everyone. The American Dream is achieved through sacrifice, risk-taking and hard work, not by chance.] through the "lens" of the two "great commandments":
 ["Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied:
 "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it:
 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:36-40]
