Introduction:

- 1. You and I are transient, but we are also **immortal**.
- Our NOW began on our <u>birthdate</u> and our FOREVER will begin after our <u>deathdate</u>.
- 3. We need God's **wisdom** to prepare for our NOW and our FOREVER.

Texts: Psalm 90:10-12; James 4:13-17; 2 Cor. 5:9-10

A. How Long Before our NOW Expires?

1. Determining factors:

- a. Our chronological age, or number of **years** we have already passed
- b. Our physical age, conditioned by our holistic **health**
- c. Our sense of meaning and purpose
- d. Our survival mood

2. Common reasons why people self-terminate

- a. Lonliness: a sense of aloneness
- b. Pain: physical, psychological, emotional
- c. Judas' complex due to remorse or guilt
- d. Self -atonement
- e. Punitive action on others
- f. **Affectionate** care for others
- g. **Hopeleness** is considered the major reason
- h. Momentary insanity
- i. Wrong doctrine
- 3. **Caution:** Get pastoral or psychiatric counselling if you face any of these suicidal symptoms.

B. How do We Prepare for our Temporal Existence?

1. Career choice

- a. What's our **passion**?
- b. Is our chosen career **marketable**?

2. Marital choice

- a. To marry or **not** to marry?
- b. Wisdom on who to marry?

3. Family Building

- a. Have **children** or not? How many?
- b. Husband and wife **rule**: Love and submission
- c. Parental influence: The key to child-rearing

4. Time management

- a. Alan Lakein said: "To <u>waste</u> your time is to waste your life, but to <u>master</u> your time is to master your life, and make the most of it."
- b. Alan Lakein's question: "Is this the **best** use of my time right now?"

5. Money management

Five Don'ts:

- a. Don't spend your money before you make it.
- b. Don't spend more than what you make.
- c. Don't buy expensive things that <u>lose</u> in value.
- d. Don't buy things just to keep up with the Joneses.
- e. Don't buy expensive things just for status symbol to impress people.

Five Do's:

- a. Work hard for your money.
- Have more money by earning <u>extra</u> income and by <u>lowering</u> your expenses.
- c. Practice the 80/20 money principle.
- d. Practice the John <u>Wesley</u> principle: Make all you can, save all you can, give all you can.
- e. Practice God's money principle: Proverbs 3:5-6; Luke 6:38; Malachi 3:10-11

6. Retirement preparation

- a. When should you begin saving for your retirement?
- b. Calculate how much money you will need to keep your standard of living.
- c. Don't **spend** your retirement savings unless it is absolutely necessary.

C. When and How should we Prepare for our Eternal Destiny?

- 1. **Now** is the time (2 Cor. 6:1-2).
- 2. Make it our goal to **please** God (2 Cor. 5:9-10).
- 3. Make it our purpose to **glorify** God in whatever we do (1 Cor. 10:31).
- 4. God said, "Prepare to meet your God" (Amos 4:12).
