Text: John 16:33

- 1. No one is exempt from trouble.
- 2. What trouble means.
- 3. Everybody is familiar with trouble even in America.
- 4. This message will present circumstantial evidences that Christ is the Master of Circumstances.

5. Q & A

- **Q#1:** Why is Christ the Master of Circumstances?
- **A#1:** Because Christ is the Creator and Sustainer of the universe. (John 1:1, 3; Col. 1:16-17; Heb. 1:3)

The GOOD NEWS is: You and I can be the master of our adversities and life-threatening circumstances when we become totally committed to Christ as our Lord and Master.

- **Q#2:** In one word, what is the root cause of the challenging circumstances that could test our faith in Christ as our Lord and Master?
- **A#2:** The one word is LOSS.
- **Q#3:** How can we deepen our faith in Christ as the Master of Circumstances?
- **A#3:** By having a deeper understanding of the circumstantial evidences that Christ is the Master of Circumstances.

A. The Evidence from His Birth (Matt. 2:1-2, 9-11)

- 1. Christ commanded a star to guide the Maji to come to Bethlehem
- to worship Him as King. Remember, although Christ was born as a baby, He did not cease to be God.
- 2. What are symbolized by the gifts of the Maji to Christ (v. 11)?
- 3. Evidently, Christ was the Master of the Circumstances surrounding His birth, beginning with His miraculous conception and His virgin birth.

B. The Evidence from His Death

- 1. Christ died on the cross voluntarily for us (John 10:11, 17-18).
- 2. Christ died on the cross according to God's purpose (Acts 2:23).

Note: Evidently, Christ was the Master of the Circumstances surrounding His death on the cross.

C. The Evidence from His Burial

- 1. Christ demonstrated that He is the Master of death by His resurrection (Matt. 28:1-7)
- 2. Christ confirmed to Apostle John that He is the Master over death (Rev. 1:8, 17-18).
- Note: Evidently, Christ was the Master of the Circumstances surrounding His birth, His death, His burial, and His resurrection.
