Big Idea: How to build your life and your home to last

Text: Matthew 7:21-27

A. Believe in the PERSON of Christ: Who He is and why believe in Him?

1. He is the eternal word: God who became flesh for you (John 1:1-14)
2. He created and sustains the universe (John 1:3; Col 1:15-17; Heb. 1:3)
3. He is the giver of eternal life to whoever believes in Him (John 3:16)
4. He conquered death for you (Rev. 1:8, 17-18)

INSIGHTS:

- a. Why is Christ worthy of our complete trust?
- b. What should we do to build our life and our home to last?

B. Follow the PRECEPTS of Christ

1. Christ central message: the kingdom of God (Matt. 5:1-3, 10, 20; 6:9-10; 7:21-23, 33)
2. God's kingdom is not just the universe He created
3. God's kingdom is our heart that is surrendered to His dominion over our life
4. God's kingdom is God's lordship or rulership over our life - our time, talents and treasures

INSIGHTS: Matthew 6:33

- a. What should be our priority: God's kingdom or things?
- b. What happens when things become our priority? (Matt. 6:24; Luke 12:15)
- c. Timely warning (2 Tim. 3:1-4)
- d. What does our conscience and the Holy Spirit tells us?

C. PRACTICES to build our life and our home

1. PRAY to God together (Matt. 6:9-13)
2. WORSHIP God together (John 4:23-24; Heb. 10:25)
3. SERVE God together (Joshua 24:14-15)


