Introduction:

Conclusion:

Read: Genesis 28:10-22

1. Like Jacob, was there a night in your life when God blessed you, and you blessed God? Look at verses 16-22.
2. At home or abroad, there are God's servants doing mission work among people in spiritual darkness--like family members who choose darkness than light. How can you help such people?
3. You cannot bless and praise God without being blessed by God yourself.
 - a. How can you keep yourself from being preoccupied with yourself that you bless God in order to get God's blessing?
 - b. How did God humble Himself to bless you? Read: Phil. 2:5-11
4. Are you going through any darkness in your personal life, your relationship with family, friends, or fellow believers? Read any of the Pilgrim Psalms 120-134 for enlightenment, inspiration, and comfort.
