Introduction:

Text: Psalm 90: 1-12

Today's message: "Live Everyday in View of Eternity" deals with these pertinent questions based on the sermon series, "In Times Like These How Should We Live?"

FIRST QUESTION: What Do These Times Look Like?

Answer: They look like the times prophesied by Christ and His apostles.

Christ's end time prophecy – Matthew 24:1-44 Will focus on verses 12-14

Apostle Paul's end time prophecy – 2 Timothy 3:1-5

Apostle Peter's end time prophecy -2 Peter 3:3-10

SECOND QUESTION: Where Do Times Like These Point Us?

They point us to the greatest event in Biblical History – Thess. 4:13-18

Ask our self: Am I ready for Christ's coming anytime?

THIRD QUESTION: Where are People Headed in Eternity?

To heaven with God for real believers in Christ – John 14:1-3

To hell with Satan for unbelievers – Rev. 20:14-15; 21:6-8

Self-check: Am I sure where I will be and with whom I'll be with in eternity?

FOURTH QUESTION: How should we live everyday in view of eternity?

The best answer I know: Keep falling in love with Jesus –

a. because He first loved you – 1 John 4:19

b. because of His love, He died for you – 2 Cor. 5:14-15

How do we show our love for Jesus?

by obeying what He commands – John 14:15

by keeping our first love for Him – Rev. 2:2-5

by being His witnesses to others – Acts 1:8

Conclusion:
