Know Your Antagonist

Introduction:

BIG IDEA: The Christian life is a spiritual warfare. How to emerge victorious and remain victorious is the burden of today's message.

Text: Eph. 6:10-12; 1 Peter 5:5-9

Note: Satan and his cohorts are our antagonists.

A. Satan's Composite Profile

- 1. "Father of lies" (John 8:44)
- 2. "Accuser of the brethren" (Rev. 12:9-10)
- 3. "Roaring Lion" (1 Peter 5:8-9)

B. Satan's Consummate Purpose

- 1. To entice people with his promise of power and glory to worship him, as he tried in his temptation of Jesus (Matt 4:8-10)
- 2. To get as many people he can to be with him in hell (Matt 25:41; Rev. 20:10)

C. Satan's Calculated Plan

- 1. Undermined and twist God's word to suit people's self interest and cause them to disobey God, as he did with Adam and Eve (Gen 2:15-16; Gen 3:1-6)
- 2. Camouflage himself as angel of light to deceive people (2 Cor. 11:14)
- 3. Divide and conquer to collapse a nation, a family, or a church (Matt. 12:25; 1 Cor. 1:11-12)

D. Biblical Strategies on How to Defeat Satan's Purpose and Plan to Destroy Us

- 1. Put on the full armor of God (Eph. 6:10-11)
- 2. Use God's written Word to resist Satan's' temptation, as Jesus did when He was tempted in the wilderness (Matt 4:1-10)
- 3. Submit yourself to God and resist the Devil (James 4:7-8)
