## TABLETALK QUESTIONS

1. Share with your group how you are coping after the shelter-in-place has been mandated a month ago.
2. Read the whole chapter of Psalm 57. We have known David all along as a great warrior who killed the giant and all sorts of beasts. Why does verse 1 describe David as being powerless?
3. Read verse 4 and describe the kind of people who are trying to pursue him. How would you relate this to the virus that is trying to pursue us?
4. Read verse 6. How did David describe his emotional pain and being in the pit? What does this tell you about King David the Warrior?
5. Read verse 1 again and describe how David describe God's protection.
6. Read verse 2. The Hebrew word for "purpose" here in the New Living Translation is *gamar*. Other Bible translations render this word as: "the God who will fulfill" or "the God who will bring everything to an end." What assurance can you get from this simple but yet profoundly powerful word?
7. Verse 3 tells us about three great promises of God. Can you identify and describe them? How is this applicable in our situation these days?
8. Lastly, read verse 7 and describe the confidence of David. What was the practical demonstration of this confidence?
9. Close this sharing by singing the Song of Engedi (v. 7-11) and thank God for his protection, purpose, promise and peace.
