A. WELCOME

B. WORD

1. Read 2 Samuel 7:2; Genesis 22:2; 2 Chronicles 3:1. What is the significance of rooting our dream to what God has spoken to us in the past just like David's commitment to God's promises a thousand years earlier?
2. Read 2 Samuel 7:4-16. How did God respond to David's desire to build Him a temple? What happens when God becomes the central focus of our plans?
3. Read 2 Samuel 7:18-20; 27-29. When Nathan spoke to David what God has told him, how did David respond? How can we personally apply this in our own lives?
4. Read 2 Samuel 24:18-25. What was David willing to do to in the location God wanted him to build the temple? What are the requirements in fulfilling our dreams and aspirations?
5. Read 1 Chronicles 28:3-6; 10-12. David performed his role in building the temple of God, but it was his son, Solomon who was able to put everything in sight. Why is important to leave a legacy for the next generation? How and when should we do it?

C. WORSHIP

Using the "My Dream" in the bulletin insert, share to your Life Group the "DREAM" that God has placed in your heart. You can either draw a picture or write a sentence or phrase that resembles about that dream. After this, begin to pray for one another that by His grace, these dreams will be fulfilled.
