Big Idea: Depend on God even in the face of hopelessness and delay.

INTRO:

Which would you rather have: storms or delays?

A. THE UNFORGOTTEN PEOPLE

- 1. Delays can be confusing despite our virtues (v. 5-6)
- 2. Delays can be frustrating when we lose our worth and **value** (v. 7)

B. THE <u>UNRELENTING</u> FAITH

- 1. In seasons of delay, we need to keep our **posture** (v. 8-10)
- 2. In seasons of delay, we need to keep **praying** (v. 11-14)

C. THE UNSCHEDULED BLESSING

- 1. During the delay, we let go of our right to **know** what God is doing (v. 18)
- During the delay, we let go of our ability to <u>schedule</u> things according to our timeline (v. 19-20)
- During the delay, we let go of our capacity to <u>control</u> our outcome (v. 21-22, 57-58, 65-66)

CONCLUSION

We must remember three things during delays: humanity, divinity and history.
