- 3. A result of quantity and quality of time spent

C. Rooted in the Heart of Jesus (Acts 7:54-60)

- 1. The alliance of the God-Head
- 2. The affirmation of Jesus
- 3. The alignment to Jesus' first priority (Mt. 1:21; 2 Pet.3:9)
