#### **TABLE TALK DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. In what ways does Daniel's situation mirror similarities you are facing?
- 2. Has there been a time in your life where your title, or position, or even possessions edged ahead of your identity in Christ?
  - "Habit Stacking" is attaching a new behavior you'd like to incorporate, to one you are already engaged in. Such as when you eat a meal, you take a moment to thank God for something. Or when you go for a walk, you talk to God about your journey with Him.
- 3. What current habit in your life could you potentially attach a time of prayer, bible reading or reflection to? Or, share something you are already doing routinely to turn your heart toward "what is eternal"?
- 4. What challenges do you face to weekly be engaged in a Christian Community, such as Life Groups, Church services or other activities that are centered around Christ? Discuss how those challenges can be overcome.
- 5. Take a moment and pair up with someone. Point out a godly characteristic you see in each other's life. Brainstorm one or two ways those characteristics can be utilized to help people know or grow in God.
- 6. What was one "takeaway" from the sermon that spoke to you or your situation?
- 7. Pray for one another or all together regarding your "takeaways".
