INTRO:

Unexpected news...

A. THE SHEPHERD'S BURDEN

- 1. Shepherds were sidelined (v. 8)
- 2. Shepherds were viewed with skepticism (v. 9)
- 3. Shepherds were stereotyped (v. 10)

B. THE SHEPHERDS <u>BLESSINGS</u>

- 1. The shepherds were witnesses of the Messiah (v. 11-16)
- 2. The shepherds were messengers of wonder (v. 17-18a)
- 3. The shepherds teaches us pure worship (v. 20)

CONCLUSION:

How can we be a witnesses of God's work this season...

- 1. Be **humble**. God's greatest work is often given to the ordinary and the overlooked.
- 2. Be **faithful**. God's word requires faith and action.
- 3. Be **joyful**. God's gift is meant to be shared with joy.

A. The Shepherds' Burden

- 1. Read Luke 2:8-10. Why do you think God chose shepherds—outcasts of society—to receive the announcement of Jesus' birth?
- 2. Have you ever felt overlooked or undervalued? How does this passage encourage you?
- 3. How can we reflect God's heart by valuing those who are often marginalized?

B. The Shepherds' Blessing

- 1. Read Luke 2:11-20. How did the shepherds respond to the angel's message? What can we learn from their immediate obedience?
- 2. Is there a step of faith God is calling you to take without delay?
- 3. The shepherds shared what they had seen and heard, and others were amazed. What makes sharing our personal experience of God so powerful?
- 4. Who can you share God's joy and truth with this week?
- 5. How does experiencing God's work in your life lead you to worship?
- 6. What can you do this week to make worship a central part of your daily life?

Closing

Reflection Question: What stood out to you most in this discussion, and how will you apply it this week?

Prayer Time:

- 1. Praise God for His work in your life.
- 2. Lift up specific people you want to invite for out Christmas Candlelight Service on December 22.
- 3. Share and discuss how your Life Group can help in the preparation of your Christmas market booths.
